2020 NSW Post-School Destinations and Experiences Survey

This fact sheet provides a high-level overview of findings from the 2020 NSW Post-School Destinations and Experiences Survey relating to all school leavers, including early school leavers and Year 12 completers.

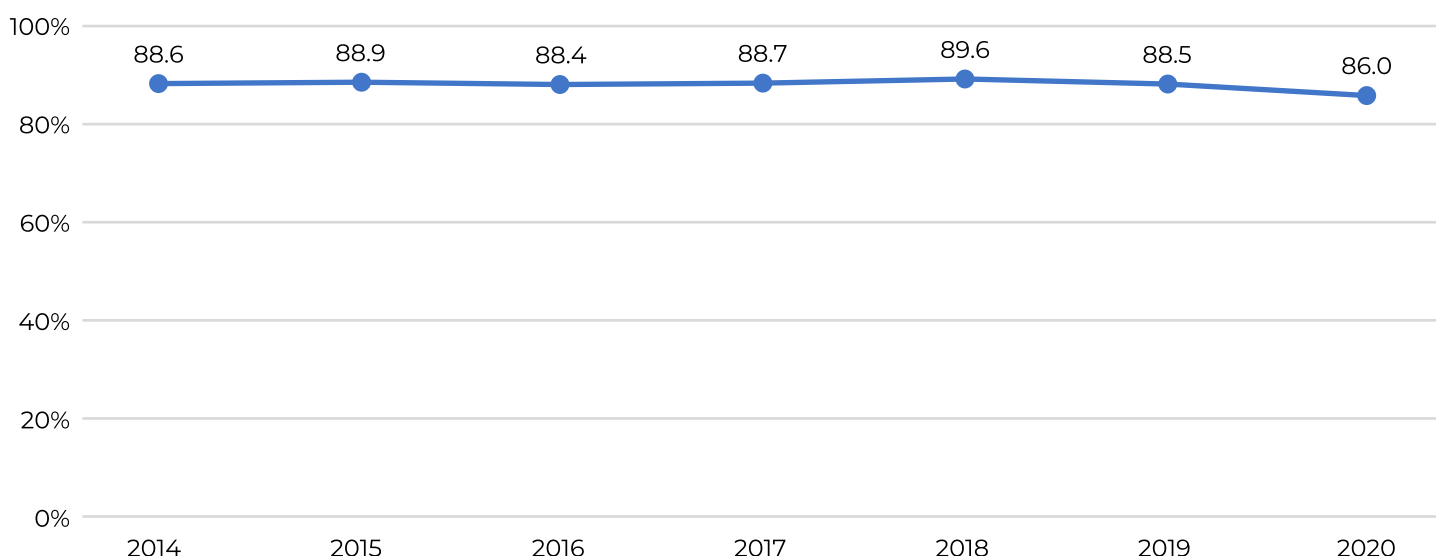
In 2020, a total of 24,843 school leavers completed the survey.

Post-school destinations of all school leavers in 2020

In 2020, 86.0% of all school leavers were in education, training or employment. The remainder were either looking for work or not in the labour force, education or training.



The proportion of recent school leavers involved in higher education, training or employment has decreased since 2014.



* NILFET means not in the labour force, education or training.

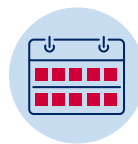

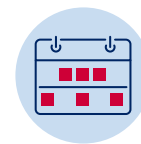
