Reason	The Regulatory Authority has substantiated a breach of Section 166(3) of the Education and Care Services National Law - Offence to use inappropriate discipline
The Regulatory Authority has accepted an enforceable undertaking on the following terms:	<p>The educator will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. ensure conduct in interacting with children in the care of an education and care service is respectful and maintains the dignity and rights of the child; b. abide by all policies and procedures at an education and care service, and, in particular, those pertaining to interactions with children; c. give each child positive guidance and encouragement towards acceptable behaviour in an appropriate manner; d. not engage in behaviour or take any action that is intended to, or might otherwise reasonably be perceived to, intimidate or humiliate a child; e. Support protective behaviour, content and learning for children in the care of an education and care service; f. Maintain awareness and understanding of the existence and application of current child protection law; and g. ensure the educator advises the approved provider or nominated supervisor of any education and care service the educator may be employed at is advised of the existence and the terms of this undertaking.
