

# NSW Training Awards 2026

## How to nominate as an organisation

Nominations must be submitted through the NSW Training Awards online nomination portal.



### 1. Understand the rules

### 2. Sign up or log in to the online portal

### 3. Confirm your email

Check your inbox to confirm your email address (new users only)

Tip: Check your 'spam/junk' email folder



### 4. Start a nomination

- Select 'state' as your region
- Select your award category
- Enter organisation name OR collaboration title

**Note:** Once you start a nomination you can save, go back in and edit anytime during the nomination period.



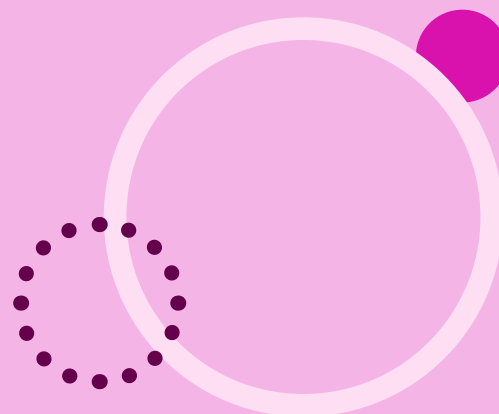
### 5. Complete the tabs

- Entry Details
- Entry Criteria
- Supporting Attachments
- Declaration



### 6. Check your email

Check to ensure you received a confirmation email on the successful lodgement of your nomination.



## Next Steps

### Nomination Process

Once nominations close, all nominees will be contacted by the NSW Training Awards team to be advised of nomination progress.

### State Level Process

Shortlisted nominations will be invited for a state interview in May 2026 online. A judging panel will select the state finalists and overall winner.

State finalists are invited to attend the NSW Training Awards presentation event in August in Sydney where the state winners will be announced.

### National Level Process

State organisation award winners must go through another shortlisting with the Australian Training Awards.

If selected as a finalist for the Australian Training Awards, shortlisted organisations will be invited to the Australian Training Awards Presentation dinner in Sydney in late November/early December.
