Playground	• Use equipment correctly • Walk on hard surfaces • Wear a hat • Keep pathways clear	• Put rubbish in the bins • Share • Take turns • Return equipment when finished	• Follow the game rules • Play in bounds
Toilet	• Shut the door • Flush the toilet after use • Wash your hands • Walk inside	• Respect the privacy of others • Wait your turn • Keep the toilet tidy • Turn off the taps	• Be water wise • Promptly return to your class or the playground • Use the toilets at appropriate time
