

Henry Parkes Equity Resource Centre

The Henry Parkes Equity Resource Centre supports the development and implementation of equity programs in NSW government schools.

The Centre assists teachers and educators by providing:

- advice about research and resources to support teaching and learning programs
- access to a wide range of contemporary resources
- facilities for professional learning activities.

Equity Resource Library

Over 40,000 resources make up the collection, including:

- professional readings
- teaching and learning materials
- multi-media classroom resources. These materials support primary and secondary schools to meet the needs of students from diverse backgrounds.

All departmental staff, pre-service teachers and teachers at Community Language Schools can access the Centre's library resources by completing and submitting a membership form.

Staff at the library are able to support borrowers in the selection and use of resources.

The collection includes teaching and professional learning materials that support student learning in:

- literacy
- numeracy
- student engagement and retention
- Aboriginal education
- teacher quality
- connected learning
- community languages.

The library collection also includes:

- New Arrivals kits
- Cultural artefacts kits
- Reconciliation kits
- Class sets of literary texts
- Preschool kits.

Conference and meeting rooms

The centre has a large conference room which can accommodate up to 60 people in theatre style or 42 in cabaret style. The room can be partitioned into two smaller rooms.

The meeting room will accommodate up to ten people.

Interactive whiteboards, video conferencing facilities and wireless internet are available.

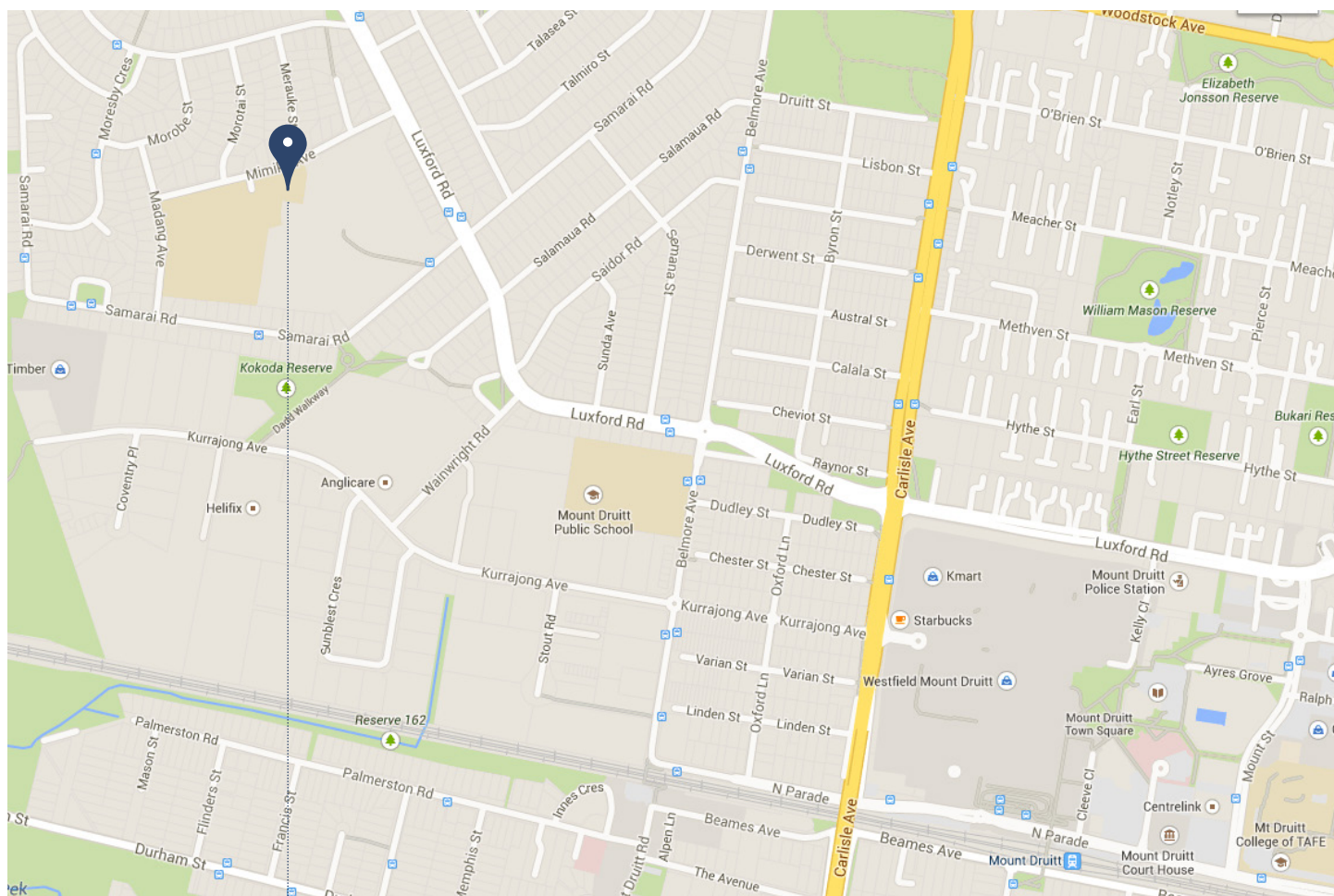
